### NOTIFICATION OF A BASIC ENVIRONMENTAL ASSESSMENT FOR THE PROPOSED INSTALLATION OF A TRUNK WATER MAIN, ASSAGAY, DURBAN

Notice is hereby given that the eThekweni Municipality's Water & Sanitation Unit has lodged an application for environmental authorisation with the KwaZulu-Natal Department of Agriculture and Environmental Affairs (DAEA) in terms of the National Environmental Management Act, 1998 and Environmental Impact Assessment (EIA) Regulations GNR 385 & GNR 386, as amended, for the proposed installation of a trunk water main between Gevers and Fraser Roads in Assagay, Durban. Arcus GIBB (Pty) Ltd has been appointed as the independent Environmental Assessment Practitioner (EAP) to compile the application and undertake the associated Basic Assessment Process. Project details: The eThekweni Water & Sanitation proposes to install a 400mm diameter steel water main pipe within the road reserve from the inter-section of Gevers and Assagav Roads, along

Hlupeka Place and portions of Kassier Road, Assagay Crescent and Alverstone Road, to the existing 400mm diameter water main in Fraser Road. The trunk water main pipeline will be approximately 2.9km long and is intended to provide support to the existing 200mm diameter water main that currently feeds the Summerhills area, where there is a demand for additional water. Public Involvement: All interested and/or affected parties (IAPs) are invited to participate by registering comments related to the project in writing within 30 days of the issuing of this notice. While the municipality subsidizes running costs, R 27 100 is required from a levy by property owners in the first year. As this proposal is based on the conservation of significant biodiversity, a single additional rate of 0,0001 for every Rand in property value is being recommended for all categories of property.
