LANDSCAPING AND RECYCLING OF LOON ROAD CEMETERY

Notice is hereby given in terms of the KWAZULU-NATAL CEMETERIES AND CREMATORIA ACT, NO.12 OF 1996 Section 23, of the eThekweni Municipality's intention to set aside Loon Road Cemetery as a landscaped cemetery as per the Council Resolution dated the 31st of October 2007. The intention of the Resolution is to transform an existing cemetery into a landscaped park cemetery. This cemetery format will enhance the existing landscape, beautify the area, promote greening and result in cost effective maintenance and the provisioning of graves. The use of upright headstones will therefore no longer be permitted at the cemetery. Existing headstones will be moved to a demarcated portion of the cemetery to create a garden of remembrance. Graves will be marked with grave stones laid level to the ground. All graves that are not under lease and are

over ten years old will be recycled. Families are advised that should they wish to retain the rights to reuse or reserve a grave from further use, they are to contact the office of the Deputy Head Parks Leisure and Cemeteries, in order to apply for a ten year lease of the grave. Any person, who does not intend to lease the grave where a family member has been buried and objects to it being recycled, should raise his/her objection by writing within 30 days of the publication of this advertisement to the Deputy Head Parks Leisure and Cemeteries.
