port is to be served primarily through a new interchange on the N2 with a new link road that will connect the N2 with the R102 to the west.

Over the past 10 years some of the major projects include: Queen Nandi Drive from North Coast Road to Mandela Road in KwaMashu; upgrading of the Western Freeway including introducing Public Transport Lanes; the phased upgrading of Chris Hani (North Coast) Road from two to four lanes through to the N2; and Shepstone Street from Mahatma Gandhi (Point) to K.E. Masinga (Old Fort) roads'

Other projects of the past decade include the improvement of roads in Hillcrest; Harry Gwala (Booth) Road from Spine Road in Westville to Rick Turner (Francois) Road; Bhejane Road in KwaMashu; D403 link road in Inanda; upgrading Bellair Road; the widening of Dr Solomon Mahlangu (Edwin Swales) Drive to six lanes; and upgrading the KwaDabeka bus route.

A section of Felix Dlamini (Brickfield) Road is being widened to 4 lanes and the new Khangela Bridge linking Bayhead to Sydney roads is being built.

Over the last five years 320km of sidewalks, 59 pedestrian bridges and 120km of new roads have been provided and 130km of gravel roads have been tarred.

In total some 400km of roads were resurfaced in the last three years.

The R102 is being upgraded by the KZN Department of Transport to a four-lane arterial from the area of the airport through to the intersection with MR93 (KwaMashu Highway).

The public transport lane on the Western Freeway has been highly successful in providing priority for public transport vehicles and easing congestion and work on the R175m Nkosi Albert Luthuli Freeway (M4) public transport lanes will be completed in May 2010.

A major upgrade is being undertaken in the Warwick Junction transport hub so that it becomes a multi-modal transport precinct with better safety and efficiency, plus improved access.

Private cars will be rerouted over the flyover, so that mainly buses and taxis will be allowed through Warwick. The inbound viaduct is due for completion in January 2010 at a cost of R220m, the outbound viaduct in May 2010 at a cost of R210m.

Public transport ranks and pedestrian facilities will be enhanced, with the removal of vehicular/pedestrian conflicts.

New retail areas will accommodate the area's 12 000-plus traders and the retail requirements of Warwick Junction's visitors.

We'll certainly keep moving on the roads our great team of engineers are building.
