## EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

### EXPRESSION OF INTEREST FOR CIVIL ENGINEERING CONSULTANTS: LABOUR INTENSIVE CONSTRUCTION PROJECTS

The eThekweni Municipality has certain projects that it intends implementing using Labour Intensive Construction (LIC) methodologies with the Expanded Public Works Programme (EPWP), one of government's short-to-medium term programmes aimed at reducing unemployment. For this purpose, it is required that civil engineering consultants that meet certain requirements over-and-above the normal eligibility requirements submit expressions of interest for inclusion in a database/panel for LIC projects to be commenced within the next two years. The person responsible for the design and documentation of the labour intensive works, must be accredited with the NQF level 7 unit standard "Develop and Promote

Labour Intensive Construction Strategies". The person who is responsible to the employer for the administration of the contract must be accredited with the NQF level 5 unit standard "Manage Labour Intensive Construction Projects". Only consultants who have been awarded Full Accreditation need submit proposals. Proposals must be submitted in the following format and failure to do so may render the proposal invalid:  
1. Name of company  
2. Physical address  
3. Names, qualifications and accreditation certificate/s for each of the individuals to be engaged on the project  
4. Any additional/relevant information
