Social Development, part of the Health Unit requires the services of an organisation to manage a Sakhisizwe Reception Centre which is situated in the city centre. The Service Organisations in the Street Children Sector are therefore requested to submit expressions of interest to manage the said centre for a period of three months. These organisations must submit a detailed CV indicating all the relevant experience in their submission. The services offered at Sakhisizwe Reception Centre are as follows: receiving of children that have been removed from the streets, screening

of the received children, working closely with eThekweni Municipality's different Units and the Welfare District Office, referral to 1st/2nd/3rd phase shelters, facilitating reunification of children with their families/communities, and ensuring the safety of the received children. The Sakhisizwe Reception Centre operates 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including public holidays. The Service Organisation is expected to fully manage the Sakhisizwe Reception Centre for a period of three months as a pilot.
