### NATIONAL POLIO AND MEASLES CAMPAIGN - 2007

The months of May and June 2007 have been dedicated to the National Polio and Measles Campaign. The main purpose of this campaign is to eradicate Polio/eliminate Measles. By giving Polio and Measles vaccine to as many children as possible, over a short period of time, in a large geographic area, transmission of Measles and Wild Polio Virus is interrupted.

#### Target Age Group:

During this campaign:

- All children less than 5 years of age will receive two doses of Oral Polio Vaccine, four weeks apart [during a first and second round]
- All children 9 months to less than 5 years will receive

ONE dose of Measles Vaccine [during the first round]

- Doses are given regardless of the immunization status of the child
- Only children in the non-target age group (over 5 years) who present in the Campaign and who have missed their routine immunization can be immunized during the Campaign, to prevent missed opportunities.

#### Dates for the Campaign

- First Round Polio and Measles 5 - 13 May 2007
- Second round Polio 9 - 17 June 2007

### INCREASE IN ELECTRICITY TARIFFS

We wish to advise our customers of the following annual increases effective from 1st July 2007. These tariffs are subject to the approval of the NERSA (National Energy Regulator of South Africa). The overall tariff increase is 7.5% which is the combination of the following individual increases:

#### Residential Tariffs

Scale 3 and 4 (Credit Meter)	7.9%
Scale 8 and 9 (Prepayment)	7.9%
Scale 12 (Free Basic Electricity)	7.9%

#### Business Tariffs

Scale 1 (Business and General)	6.19%
Scale 2 (Two Rate)	1.82%
Scale 5,6 and 7	9%
Scale 10 (Prepayment)	6.83%
Scale 11 (Prepayment)	1.97%

#### Time of Use (Bulk Supply)

7.94% on the Energy Charge  
7.94% on the Demand Charge

#### Other Bulk Supplies

9.6% on the Energy Charge  
9.6% on the Demand Charge  
9% on the Service Fee
