PUBLIC NOTICE

ETHEKWINI WATER AND SANITATION

The current average daily water demand in the Municipal Area is exceeding the current available sustainable supply. In order to reduce the possibility of water restrictions, increase efficiencies and continue to extend the water supply to new consumers, eThekweni Water and Sanitation is implementing many water conservation and demand management measures. One of the most immediate and effective measures to reduce water loss is to eliminate all excessive water pressures in the reticulation network. Notice is therefore hereby given to all water consumers within the eThekweni

Municipality's area of jurisdiction that the operating pressures of the water reticulation network are to be reduced in line with the implementation of new pressure standards. The new standards that have been introduced will ensure that the maximum pressure in the reticulation network will not exceed 60m. The minimum pressure to consumers with the full pressure level of service will not drop below 25m, and the minimum pressure to consumers with the semi-pressure level of service (Roof Tank System) will be 15m. These changes have been implemented within the provisions of Section II. (1) (2) of the current Water Supply Bylaws, which can be viewed at www.durban.gov.za.

Furthermore, each consumer's attention, particularly all non-domestic consumers, is drawn to their responsibility for the design and maintenance of all internal and fire-fighting pipework in accordance with Section VI (6) and Section VI (7) of the Water Supply Bylaws. The implementation of the new pressure standards will commence immediately and no further notice shall be provided in this regard.
