### DURBAN FRESH PRODUCE MARKET: APPLICATION FOR TRADING OPPORTUNITIES

#### Background

The Durban Fresh Produce Market, situated at 81 Flower Road, Clairwood, is the fourth largest fresh produce market in the country. Currently 6 market agents operate on the market and are responsible for the bulk sale of fresh produce. The annual turnover of the market over the past 3 financial years is as follows:

2008/09	R 806m
2007/08	R 731m
2006/07	R 601m

A new traders' hall has recently been constructed at the market, with the intention of partly creating business opportunities for potential traders currently not located at the market. Two different trading opportunities exist. The details, and the process to be followed in submitting an application for this space, are reflected below.

#### Trading Opportunities

Within the traders' hall, space is available for the purpose of trading in fresh produce. Applications are invited from individuals interested in obtaining trading space at the Traders Hall at the Durban Fresh Produce Market. Preference will be given to previously disadvantaged individuals and those who have experience in the fresh produce industry. All interested parties are required to attend a compulsory briefing session on

28th July 2009, at 10 am, at the conference room of the Bulk Market, situated at 81 Flower Road, Clairwood. Application forms will be made available at this briefing session.

#### Distribution Opportunities

Within the traders' hall, space has been set aside for the purpose of distributing fresh produce in bulk. Applications are invited from existing co-operatives or other organizations/ individuals that are in a position to form a co-operative within a short space of time to apply for distribution space at the Traders Hall of the Durban Fresh Produce Market. Preference will be given to previously disadvantaged individuals/ organizations and those that have experience in the fresh produce industry. All interested parties are required to attend a compulsory briefing session on 29th July 2009, at 10 am, at the conference room of the Bulk Market, situated at 81 Flower Road, Clairwood. Application forms will be made available at this briefing session.
